Have you heard about the Mercer Science and Engineering Fair?

We hope so but we would love to get you more information so you can help your children participate in the fair. It is free and the competition is open to students in grades 4 through 12 who attend school in Mercer County, NJ. This includes home school students. Like 2020, this year's fair will be held online.

Students can enter individual projects they did in the summer or during the school year. They just need to complete them before the fair in March. The competition covers all aspects of **science**, **technology**, **engineering** and **mathematics** (STEM).

The competition is divided into three groups divided by grade:

• Elementary: grades 4 and 5

• Junior: grades 6, 7 and 8

• Senior: grade 9 through 12

All students should have a presentation board and items like a lab notebook. The Senior division is interviewed by judges. The Grand Prize winner of the Senior Division receives a chaperoned **all-expense paid trip** to compete at the annual **Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF)** held in May. The top 10% of the Junior Division (grades 6-8) move on to compete in the **Broadcom Masters Competition**. Our students have gone onto ISEF and the Broadcom Masters competitions where they earned awards.

What can you do?

March 14 Elementary Division registration closes
