If you are in grades 4 through 12 and attend school in Mercer County, NJ then you are eligible to compete in the annual **Mercer Science and Engineering Fair**. The competition is free to all students and held annually in March. Like 2020, this year's fair will be held online.

You can start your project now or use one you did this summer. The competition covers all aspects of **science**, **technology**, **engineering** and **mathematics** (STEM). It is a great way for individual students to highlight their work.

The competition is divided into three groups so you compete with students in your age group. The groups include:

Elementary: grades 4 and 5

Junior: grades 6, 7 and 8

Senior: grade 9 through 12

The Grand Prize winner of the Senior Division receives a chaperoned **all-expense** paid trip to compete at the annual Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF) held in May. The top 10% of the Junior Division (grades 6-8) move on to compete in the Broadcom Masters Competition. Our students have gone onto ISEF and the Broadcom Masters competitions where they earned additional awards. You can too!
